



Dear attendees of the AAP National Conference and Exhibition:

We continue to monitor Hurricane Helene and any impact on Orlando, and we are committed to hosting a safe meeting. Key updates about what we know so far:

**The meeting is still on as planned.** We are in frequent consultation with local officials who have been sharing frequent updates with us. Despite predicted impacts on other parts of Florida, conversations with Orlando-based teams have been reassuring.

As of now, the largest effects from the storm in the Orlando area look to be Thursday afternoon into early Friday morning. You may notice slight changes to our programming due to travel disruptions, but the meeting is otherwise unchanged.

**If your travel is affected**, some things to keep in mind:

- **Hotel changes:** Any changes to a hotel reservation – either adjusting the check-in/out date or a full cancellation – should be worked out with the hotel directly.
- **Airline changes:** Many airlines offer free flight changes due to weather. We recommend using your airline app or calling the airline directly to see what's possible.

Your safety is our priority. If you are impacted by Hurricane Helene, please be safe and take care.
